Monday	<p>Reading: Informational Article "Give Me Liberty or Give Me Death" (anniversary of Patrick Henry's famous speech) reading comprehension and history content</p> <p>Writing: 1. Flow Chart on <i>The Writing Process</i> read a chart and answer questions, use the chart for writing a narrative</p> <p>2. Begin the challenge activity on Patrick Henry research, note taking, paragraph writing</p> <p>Math: Canine Calculations addition practice with multi-digit numbers with regrouping</p>
Tuesday	<p>Reading: Understanding the <i>Plot</i> reading comprehension</p> <p>Writing: 1. Write in your <i>Writing Journal</i></p> <p>2. Continue to work on the challenge activity on Patrick Henry research, note taking, paragraph writing</p> <p>Math: Menu Math practice reading a menu, math problem solving with money</p>
Wednesday	<p>Reading: Reviewing Rope reading visual aid that can be used with any book to help students summarize the plot</p> <p>Writing: 1. Write in your <i>Writing Journal</i></p> <p>2. Finish challenge activity on Patrick Henry (Edit your paper by checking to see if you have written in complete sentences, spelled everything correctly, and used proper punctuation)</p> <p>3. Read your paper to someone else writing fluency, editing, oral reading</p> <p>Math: Shell Pictograph read and understand a Pictograph, solve math story problems, create your own pictograph (higher level thinking)</p>
Thursday	<p>Reading: 1. Understanding <i>Point of View</i> reading comprehension</p> <p>2. Read your own book and use the <i>Reviewing Rope</i> to summarize the plot</p> <p>Writing: Begin writing a spring <i>Haiku</i> poetry writing</p> <p>Math: Canine Calculations subtraction practice with multi-digit numbers with regrouping</p>
Friday	<p>Reading: Reading a Timeline reading a timeline for information, historical content</p> <p>Writing: Finish writing your spring <i>Haiku</i> poetry writing</p> <p>Math: Solving Math Story Problems</p>
