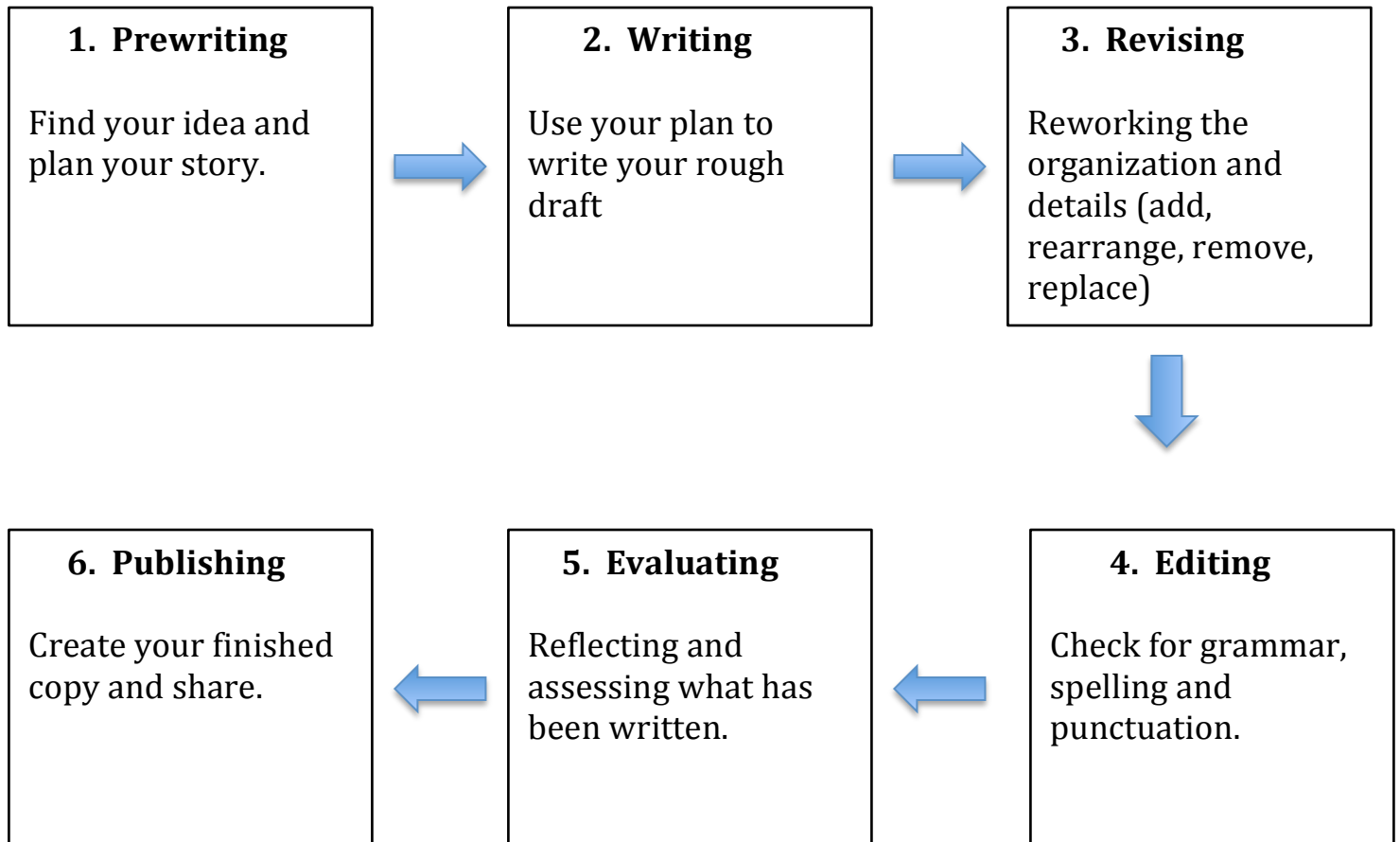


STEPS IN THE WRITING PROCESS

4. In what step would you examine your story to see if it is interesting?

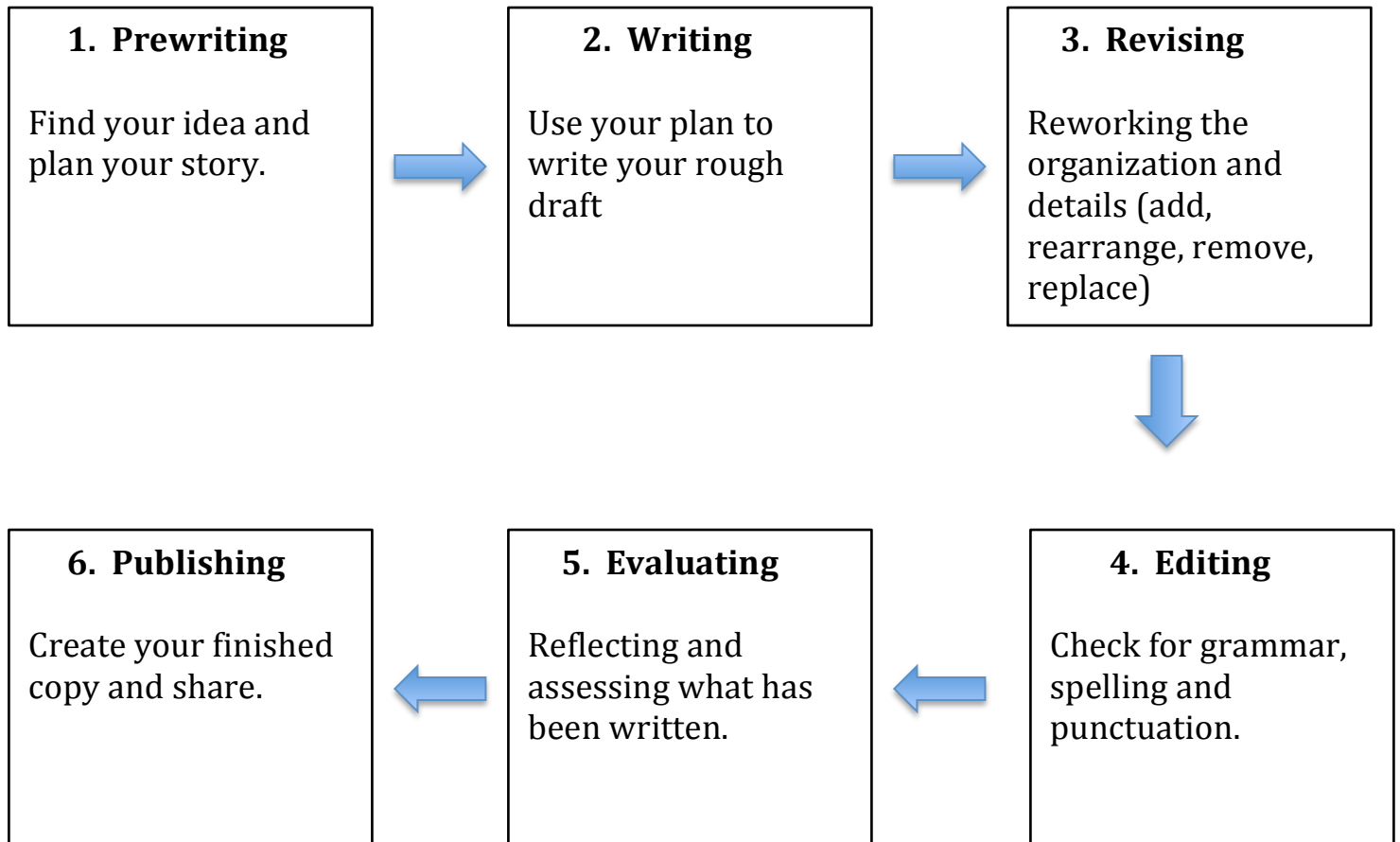

Prewriting is picking an idea and creating a plan. I keep a Writing Journal and create a story map to help me plan.

2. In what step do you correct capitalization errors?

Step 4, Editing is where you correct all spelling and grammar errors.

3. In what step would you add more descriptive details?

Step 3, Revising is where you add details or make changes to improve your story.

4. In what step would you examine your story to see if it is interesting?

Step 5, Evaluating is where you reflect on the quality of the story.
