
# **Pifferent Kinds of Sentences**



### **Declarative and Exclamatory Sentences**

A writer can use different kinds of sentences tomake their writing more interesting. A <u>declarative sentence</u> makes a statement about a person, place, thing, or idea. A <u>declarative sentence</u> ends in a period (.). An <u>exclamatory sentence</u> show strong emotion (anger, excitement, fear, surprise). An <u>exclamatory sentence</u> ends with an exclamation mark (!).



My mother went to the store today. (declarative) I can't believe I got a new bicycle! (exclamatory)
