Hyenas



There are many fascinating animals in Africa. The hyena was definitely one I won't forget. I was on safari in Botswana, Africa and that is where I had my only encounter with a spotted hyena, as seen in the photograph to the left. How it all came about is

rather interesting. We were finishing our evening safari when our guide received a message that a leopard had been spotted. It is difficult to see a leopard because they are not usually out in the open like the lions. He immediately took us to the sight. This leopard had made a kill (a small impala) and had brought his dinner up in a tree. Our guide informed us that the leopards often do this to keep the



other cats from stealing their meal. In the photo above you can see the leopard on the right and the impala on the left. The hyena was circling the tree in hopes the impala would fall down and he could escape with the leopard's dinner.

Hyenas are **scavengers** because they feed on dead animals they didn't kill. Even though hyenas love to get an easy meal they aren't just scavengers. They hunt for their food as well. Hyenas are carnivores, which means they eat only meat, but they are not that selective when it comes to what kind of meat. Hyenas will eat wildebeest, antelope, hippos, birds, jackals, lizards, foxes, porcupines, baby elephants, baby giraffes, and any other meat they can kill. Hyenas work together in clans to take down their prey.

Hyenas will eat every part of an animal, including the bones and hooves. Nothing is wasted and extra food is usually hidden. To the right is a picture of our guide holding a hyena poop. It looks like a powdered sugar donut hole. He explained that hyena manure is white because they eat all the bones of the dead



animals. Other animals will eat the hyena poop because they need the calcium. The hyenas keep the grasslands clean because they eat all of the dead animals. We never saw a decaying carcass or the skeleton of an animal. The hyena plays an important role in the African grassland ecosystem.
