

How to Make Chinese Lanterns

Chinese lanterns are important symbols during the Chinese New Year celebrations. Letting go of a lantern symbolizes letting go of the past, and preparing to start a new year. Let's make a lantern together!

- 1. Pick out any size paper in any color
- 2. Cut off a strip of paper a 1/2 inch thick keep the strip for step 9
- 3. Fold the rest of the paper in half lengthwise
- 4. Measure 1/2 inch from the top of the open edge, and draw a line straight across
- 5. Measure 1/2 inch marks along this line, then for each mark, draw the line across to the folded edge of the paper (this will make the 1/2 inch strips for the lanterns)
- 6. From the folded edge, to the line you marked in step 2, cut straight across, through both layers of paper
- 7. Open the paper, and bring the edges together like a cylinder, so the cut shapes are vertical
- 8. The folded part should be on the outside, then tape the edges together at the top, in the middle, and at the bottom
- 9. Add the strip of paper you cut in step 2 and tape it like a handle
- **Do not add any sort of candle or fire to this lantern. This is meant just for a project or hanging decor!
